#### Introduction

- Welcome & Introductions Bill Bass TCC Chair
   Mr. Bill Bass (City of Wilson) welcomed everyone and asked everyone to introduce themselves and then called the meeting to order.
- 2. Approval of Agenda
  - Mr. Bill Bass asked if everyone had an opportunity to review the agenda and asked if anyone had any additions to be made to the agenda. Being none and **UPON A MOTION** by Ms. Cynthia Jones (Edgecombe), second by Mr. Adam Tyson (Nash) the agenda was unanimously approved as written.
- 3. Minutes March 5, 2019, 2018

After reviewing the Minutes for the March 5, 2019 TCC and **UPON A MOTION** by Mr. Adam Tyson (Nash), second by Ms. Cynthia Jones (Edgecombe) the minutes for the March 5, 2019 meeting were unanimously approved.

#### Presentation

4. Strategic Investment Investments (STI) Project Prioritization P6
Mr. Craig Midgett provided a presentation on the overall STI process and the proposed changes being considered between STI P5 and P6.

#### **Discussion Items**

- 5. Review of STI P6 Current and Potential Projects
  - A list of current proposed projects and newly identified potential projects was provided with the agenda. Members were asked to review all of the projects and let UCPRPO staff know of any proposed revisions. There were no recommended changes.
- **6.** Local Methodology (Flex points between Region and Division)
  - As part of the STI P6 presentation, it was explained that there would be a new option to flex points between Regional projects and Division projects. There was a consensus that the UCPRPO probably would not desire to flex points but believe it would be a good idea to update the UCPRPO local methodology to allow flexing of points in case there was a need. It was reported that the deadline to update the methodology would be January 2020.
- 7. STI P6 Calendar
  - It was reported the deadline to submit STI P6 projects is September 2019.

The US 70 Commission held a meeting on April 28, 2019 in Kinston, NC. Mr. Salmons reported that Patrick Flanigan and himself provided a brief presentation on the ongoing NC Moves 2050 plan. He also informed members of the public meeting scheduled for May 21 for the US 70 upgrades in Princeton, NC between Pondfield Rd and the Goldsboro Bypass.

# RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT TO PURSUE GRANT FUNDING FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO CONNECT THE TOWNS OF CLAYTON AND SMITHFIELD WITH THE MOUNTAINS-TO-SEA TRAIL (MST)

**WHEREAS** the Mountains-to-Sea Trail (MST) is a concept for a continuous trail stretching from the Smoky Mountains in the west, to North Carolina's outer Banks in the east which started in the 1970's when the North Carolina General Assembly passed the North Carolina Trails System Act; and

**WHEREAS** the vision for the Mountains-to-Sea Trail (MST) is supported by a series of secretaries of the Department of Natural and Community Development; and

WHEREAS a segment of the Mountains-to-Sea Trail (MST) passes through Johnston County; and

WHEREAS Johnston County supports the development of the of the Mountains-to-Sea Trail (MST) and completed an MST Master Plan in October 2006 in partnership with the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, North Carolina Department of Transportation Bicycle and Pedestrian Division, Town of Clayton, Town of Smithfield, and Greenways Incorporated; and

**WHEREAS** the some of the benefits of trail systems to citizens include, creating Value and Generating Economic Activity, Facilitating the Use of Alternative Transportation, Improving Health through Active Living, Protecting Farmland and Open spaces, Enhancing Cultural Awareness and Community Identity; and

WHEREAS there is currently a gap within the Mountains-to-Sea Trail (MST) between the Towns of Clayton and Smithfield; and

**WHEREAS** that Upper Coastal Plain Rural Planning Organization (UCPRPO) provides transportation planning for the four counties of Edgecombe, Johnston, Nash, and Wilson; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) is the duly recognized Transportation planning policy board for the Upper Coastal Plain Rural Planning Organization (UCPRPO); and


