TAC Meeting

1. Welcome & Introductions – Kenneth Jones – TAC Chair

TAC Chair Mr. Kenneth Jones welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order. He then read the conflict of interest statement and there were no members reporting any conflicts. Mr. Salmons introduced and welcomed Ms. Suzette Ogbon as NCDOT's new representative to the UCPRPO.

Announcements

- 1. Ms. Ogbon reported that the Johnston County CTP in the process of being complete and that the CTP maps have been adopted by NCDOT and are suitable for official and legal use (2012). All other CTP's for UCPRPO have been completed. She passed out a document titled "Status of UCPRPO Comprehensive Transportation Plans June 26, 2013".
- 2. Ms. Oliver (TAC member from Town of Selma) introduced Mr. Jack Newman (TCC member from Town of Selma) to the Committee as the new appointee to the TCC from the Town of Selma.

Presentation

1. Mr. Salmons gave a presentation explaining the new ratified Strategic Mobility Funding signed into law. Discussion followed and a Resolution to Adopt the Criteria for the Quantitative Evaluation of Regional and Division Projects was presented to the Committee for approval.

Action Items

- 1. Minutes May 8, 2013 UPON A MOTION by Mr. A.P. Coleman (City of Wilson) to accept the May 8, 2013 minutes as written, second by Ms. Cheryl Oliver (Selma), the minutes were unanimously approved.
- 2. Resolution Adopting Criteria for Quantitative Evaluation for UCPRPO Approval THERE WAS A MOTION by Ms. Cheryl Oliver (Town of Selma) to adopt the Resolution and a second by Mr. Ronald McCormick (Saratoga). Discussion was then made by Mr. A.P. Coleman (City of Wilson) that he was uncomfortable with the timing and the lack of time to fully understand the Evaluation process due to its complexity. Mr. Kenneth Jones stated that he felt everyone would fill the impact of lack of funding. With no further discussion there was a vote and the Resolution was unanimously adopted.

It was discussed that the next scheduled meeting would be held on July 10th, 2013 would be canceled. That in lieu of the meeting Mr. Salmons would email the date for the next meeting to be held in September along with a list of proposed UCPRPO Projects to be removed from the SPOT list for the Committee's consideration.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING CRITERIA FOR THE QUANTITATIVE EVALUATION OF REGIONAL IMPACT PROJECTS AND DIVISION NEED PROJECTS TO ADDRESS THE STRATEGIC PRIORITIZATION FUNDING PLAN FOR TRANSPORTATION INVESTMENTS FOR REGIONS A AND DIVISION 4

WHEREAS, the Upper Coastal Plain Rural Planning Organization provides transportation planning services for Edgecombe County, Johnston County, Nash County and Wilson County, and

WHEREAS, House Bill 817 outlines the Strategic Prioritization Funding Plan for Transportation Investments; and

WHEREAS, based on this legislation quantitative, qualitative and local input criteria shall be used to rank Regional Impact Projects and Division Need Projects; and

WHEREAS, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), Rural Transportation Planning Organizations (RPOs) and the North Carolina Department of Transportation Division Engineers have been given an opportunity to define their own quantitative criteria and formulas for the quantitative evaluation of Regional Impact Projects and Division Needs Projects using the criteria outlined by the Strategic Planning Office of Transportation Workgroup; and

WHEREAS, the Upper Coastal Plain RPO is located in Regions A as defined by the legislation and the North Carolina Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, a set of criteria has been proposed to evaluate Regional Impact Projects for Region A jurisdictions based on the following quantitative criteria: 20% Benefit-Cost; 15% Congestion; 15% Safety; 10% Lane Width and 10% Shoulder Width; and

WHEREAS, the Upper Coastal Plain RPO is located in Division 4 of the North Carolina Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, a set of criteria has been proposed to evaluate Division Needs Projects for Division 4 jurisdictions based on the following quantitative criteria: 10% Benefit-Cost; 10% Congestion; 10% Safety; 10% Lane Width and 10% Shoulder Width; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Upper Coastal Plain Rural Planning Organization's Transportation Advisory Committee hereby supports the criteria for the quantitative evaluation of Regional Impact Projects and Division Need Projects to address the Strategic Transportation Investment for Regions A, and Division 4.
